Subject Matter: Abortion Bills to Repeal All Abortion Laws and Parental Notice of Abortion Act

HB 2495 and SB 1942 – Repeals All Abortion Laws in Illinois

- ✦ Removes any limits on late term, post-viability abortions, allows abortion up to the moment of birth, for any reasons, or no reason. This bill goes far beyond the New York law. (Pages 4 and 8 by Repealing the Illinois Abortion Law of 1975)
- ✦ Would allow non-physicians (physician assistant, advance practice registered nurse, or any person supervised by the above) to do surgical and chemical abortions. (Pages 2, 3, 96, 99, 100)
- ✦ Born Alive Infant Protections in jeopardy by the removal of a second physician requirement to take control of and provide immediate medical care for any viable child born alive from an abortion. Repeals requiring the use of the method of abortion on a viable unborn child that would enhance the chance of the unborn to survive the abortion. (Pages 8 by Repealing the Illinois Abortion Law of 1975 and as amended)
- ✦ Removes all existing licensing requirements and standards for abortion clinics, including late term abortion clinics. Eliminates any restrictions on where abortions may be performed. Removes penalties for performing an abortion procedure on a woman known not to be pregnant. (Pages 57-58; Pages 73-74; Pages 90-91)

- ✦ Requires all private health insurance plans to cover abortions with no co-pay, or any cost, with no exceptions for churches, synagogues, mosques, or any religious non-profits, or pro-life organizations. (Pages 65-66)
- ✦ Repeals the Abortion Performance Refusal Act, which would remove protections for pro-life doctors, nurses, and hospitals against professional repercussions for refusing to participate in abortions. (Page 8)
- ✦ It shows a disdain for unborn life at all stages of development by stripping the unborn of any independent rights under the law. (Pages 4, 49, 109, 111 ,112, 113)
- ✦ Lifts the ban on the sale of or experimentation on a fetus. (Page 8 by Repealing the Illinois Abortion Law of 1975 and as amended)

HB 2467 and SB 1594 – Repeal Parental Notice of Abortion Act of 1995.

- ✦ This Act has been in full effect since 2013 and has reduced the number of abortions on minor girls from Illinois and minor girls crossing state lines on average of 1,000 a year.
- ✦ These bills reject the parental authority and family relationship between them and their children.
